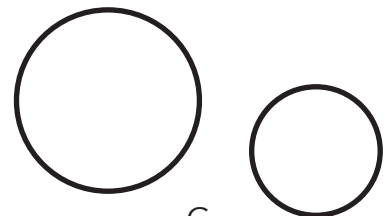
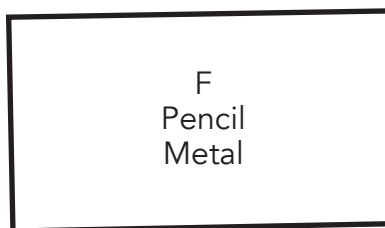
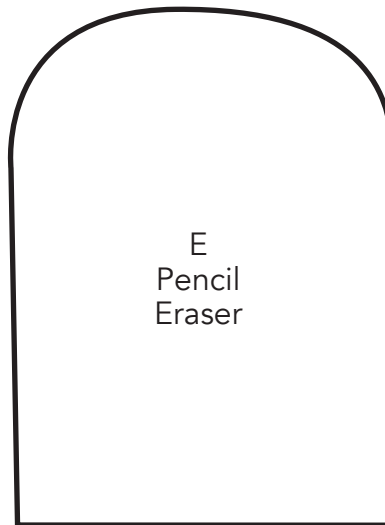
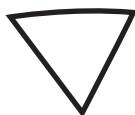
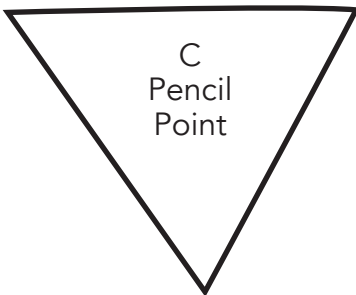
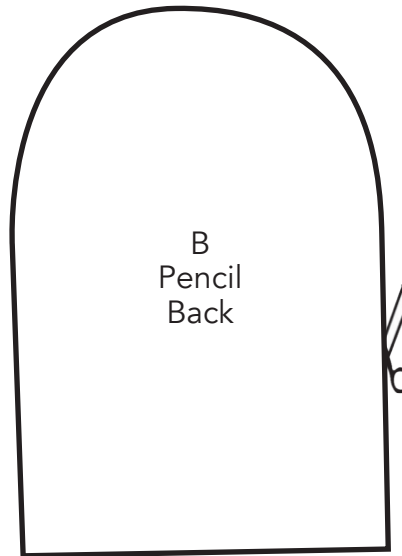
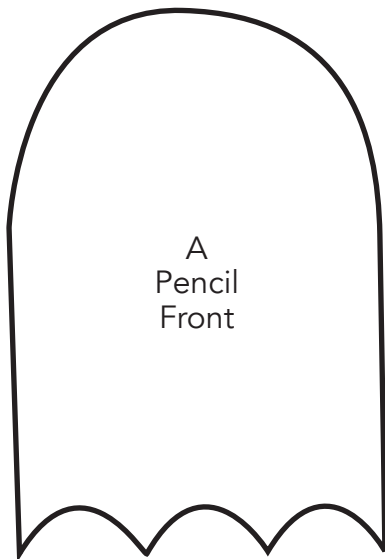


# PENCIL FINGER PUPPET

## Templates

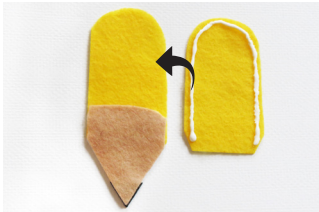


# Instructions

1. Cut out the template shapes.
2. Lay them over felt. Trace lightly with a pencil.
3. Cut out the felt shapes.



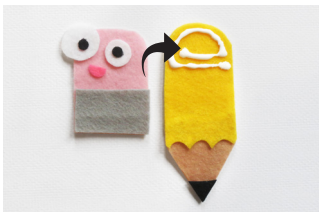
4. Glue the Pencil tips together, then glue main puppet pieces as shown below.



5. Glue the eraser tops together, then glue the eyes and mouth as shown.



6. Glue the head on top of the pencil body. Let dry for about an hour.

Fast Grab Tacky Glue

## Challenge

## Tips & Tricks

Make pencil magnets by sticking peel and stick magnets on the back of felt shapes.
